

## 2010 *Rockmont Ranger* Fact Sheet



### 1. ***What ages may participate as Rangers?***

For the 2010 A2 Session: **Ages 16-17**

For the 2010 **B1, B2, and C** Sessions: **Ages 14-17**

### 2. ***What is the Mission of the Ranger Program?***

The Rockmont Ranger Program strives to instill Christ-like character and leadership into young men. This is accomplished through wilderness expeditions that are designed to draw out and enhance the God-given qualities specific to each participant.

### 3. ***Where will Rangers go? What will they do?***

After a period of training and group building at base camp (Rockmont), Rangers will spend the majority of their time discovering beauty and solitude in one or more of the vast National Park Wilderness areas that surround us. Rockmont Ranger activities will include Backpacking, High Ropes Course Team Challenge, Canoeing, Rock Climbing, and Whitewater Rafting.

### 4. ***Is prior high adventure experience necessary to be a Ranger?***

No it is not. While Rangers need to be in good health and ready to consider new challenges, all necessary training for new activities will be provided.

### 5. ***What are the arrival and departure days for Rangers?***

For the 2010 **A2** Session [Ages 16-17] arrive at Camp June 13 and depart June 25.

For the 2010 **B1** Session [Ages 14-17] arrive at Camp June 27 and depart July 9.

For the 2010 **B2** Session [Ages 14-17] arrive at Camp July 11 and depart July 23.

For the 2010 **C** Session [Ages 14-17] arrive at Camp July 25 and depart August 6.

### 6. ***What does this program cost?***

In 2010, the cost for the Ranger Program is the same as the 13 day camper fee, \$2500.

### 7. ***Do I need any specialized gear?***

We have some specific recommendations on personal outdoor gear that will be sent to you well in advance with a packing list. Group gear (cookstoves, safety equipment, etc.) will be provided.

### 8. ***May I rent gear from Camp Rockmont?***

Yes you can! If you don't already have the recommended gear and don't feel that an investment in gear makes sense for you right now, plan to rent approved gear from Camp Rockmont. For a modest fee we will rent backpacks, sleeping bags, and rain gear to Rangers who make arrangements in advance of their session.
